## **Children's Nasal Spray Flu Vaccine**

## Quinta session date is Monday 11th November 2024.

The children's nasal spray flu vaccine is safe and effective. It's offered every year during the flu season to children to help protect them against flu.

Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating your child also protects vulnerable family members and friends.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the flu vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have received the flu nasal spray annually.

The School Aged Immunisations Team will only vaccinate children with a valid e-consent form. If you DO NOT fill the e-consent form in your child <u>will not</u> be able to have the vaccination in school.
